What are Adverse Childhood Experiences?



Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) are one of the key indicators of future mental and physical health problems. Those with an ACE score at three or above are likely to face a number of challenges throughout their lives, which can include chronic health conditions (obesity and strokes); health risk behaviors (smoking and substance misuse); social outcomes (unemployment and lack of health insurance); and mental health conditions (depression and substance use disorder).
